About Worden Farm

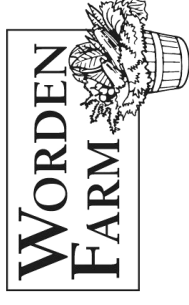
Worden Farm is a 55-acre certified organic family farm, raising crops for hundreds of local families in the Southwest Florida community. The farm is owned and operated by husband and wife team Chris and Eva Worden, Ph.D.s in plant science and ecosystem management.

The USDA-certified organic crops of Worden Farm are grown without any conventional pesticides, synthetic fertilizers, or genetically-engineered seeds. Ecological techniques are used to conserve resources and protect soil and water resources, wildlife, and human health. Worden Farm is certified organic by Quality Certification Services, an independent, USDA-authorized organic certification agency.

Harvest Shares

Worden Farm members receive a healthy harvest share each week, in season. Harvest shares consist of a balanced array of 8 or more different produce items, including salad greens, cooking greens, root crops, fruiting vegetables, culinary herbs, and occasional fruit crops and cut flowers.

A harvest share comfortably fulfills the weekly produce needs of 2 people who like to eat plenty of vegetables. Households can enroll for more than one share, or shares can be split between 2 or more families.

The harvests vary with the time of the season. One week's share might contain: a head of lettuce, a bunch of kale, a bunch of carrots, 2 tomatoes, a quart of potatoes, 2 squash, 4 oranges, a quart of green beans, a head of broccoli, and a bunch of parsley.

Most all of the produce is grown at Worden Farm. On occasion, for more variety, we include local organic or sustainable produce from neighboring farmer friends.

Membership Options

Market-style at Worden Farm

Flexible choice from an assortment of produce, for members only, at Worden Farm in Punta Gorda. Frequent bonus pick-your-own crops, like cherry tomatoes and beans. For 20 weeks, December 1 to April 13.

Farmers Market Credit

Flexible choice of produce from any of our farmers markets. Receive a pre-paid farmers market credit account, with your 10% member discount pre-applied. Choose any amount of produce at any market, anytime, and deduct from your credit. During the Fall through Spring market season. Any remaining credit at season's end is applied to the farm education program fund.

Classic Box

Beautiful box of the farm's best harvest. Each week, just go to your chosen site at the pick-up time, check your name off the list, grab your box, and go. For 20 weeks, from the first week of December to the middle of April.

Membership Fees

Membership fee is \$600 for the season. Delivery fee for boxed harvest shares at off-farm sites is \$60 for the season. There is no member work requirement, and there are no additional fees or commitments.

Institutional memberships are available for restaurants and other food service businesses. Please call the farm for details.

The \$150 deposit is entirely non-refundable. Any refund of membership payments beyond the deposit will incur an administrative fee of \$50, and are entirely non-refundable after October 1.
